**Subject: Regarding recruitment under Priority List Instructions.**

Please refer to the subject noted above.

2. In view of the instructions issued by Government of Punjab, Department of Personnel (Personnel Policies – II Branch) vide their Memo No. 11/105/98/4PP/14420 dated 21.11.2002, competent authority for recruitment in Group 'C' and 'D' posts is as per Department Service Rules and Standing Order of department. At present, recruitment under Priority List Instructions is being made by this office in the ranks of Clerk, Peons, Constables and Class-IV.
3. The competent authority for recruitment in the above ranks is as under: -

Sr. No.	Rank	Competent Authority	Rules
i.	Clerk	DGP, Punjab	As per Punjab Police Clerical Service (State Service Class-III) Rules, 1960
ii.	Peon	DIG/ Admn. CPO, Punjab	As per Punjab State (Class-IV) Rules, 1963
iii.	Constable	SSP/Comdt. concerned	As per Rule 12.1 of PPR
iv.	Class-IV (Except Peon)	DIG concerned	As per Punjab State (Class-IV) Rules, 1963

4. In the Officers meeting held on 12.09.2011 under the Chairmanship of DGP, Punjab, it has been decided that recruitment of dependent family members of Punjab Police Officers and men, who die while in service under Priority List Instructions will be made by the Range/ District/ Unit/ Wing level.
5. In view of above, henceforth recruitment in the rank of Constables and Class-IV (except peons) under Priority List Instructions will be made by the authorities in the para 3 above in the light of the Standing orders issued by this office and instructions issued by the State Govt. (Home/Personnel Department) from time to time. However, the recruitment of Clerks and Peons under Priority List Instructions will be made by this Office.
6. These Instructions will come into force w.e.f. 01.10.2011.
7. You are, therefore, requested to comply with the above instructions meticulously.
