Subject: Guidelines/procedure regarding recruitment under priority list instructions.

Please refer to this officer memo no. 14589-620/E-3(3) dated 18.11.2009, on the subject cited above.

2. It has been decided that for recruitment in the department under priority list instructions, the guidelines/procedure mentioned below be followed: -

1. The ward of NGO will be considered for recruitment as Constable. However, a candidate with exceptional qualification can be considered by DGP for enlistment as ASI on the recommendation of Screening Committee. Screening Committee before making recommendation will also conduct written test.
2. The ward of G.O. below the rank of DIG will be considered for recruitment as ASI on the recommendation of the Screening Committee after taking written test. The ward of G.O. of the rank of DIG and above will be considered for the post of Inspr. on the recommendation of the Screening Committee after the written test.
3. Candidates can be appointed as clerk provided the Screening Committee finds him suitable for the post of clerk.
4. All such PLI appointments shall be borne on Armed Battalions cadre except the wards of the Police Personnel dying while performing active policing duties. In such cases the candidate would be absorbed in the District Cadre.
5. As per prevailing Govt. Instructions "Appointment on compassionate grounds should be made only on regular basis that too only if regular vacancies meant for that purpose are available". Such PLI cases where contingent paid Job has been given should also be given regular Class-IV employment out of the regular vacancy in order of seniority
6. One inch height relaxation for otherwise fit candidate will be granted by DGP on the recommendation of the Screening Committee.
